# NEW HAMPSHIRE ASSOCIATION OF ASSESSING OFFICIALS IAAO AFFILIATE BOARD OF DIRECTOR'S MEETING

# Minutes June 9, 2020 Virtual Meeting via Zoom

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- I. Call to Order President James Rice.
- II. Roll Call A Quorum of Members being present (14 members). Meeting began at 10:06 am.

New Members/Guest - None

- III. Secretary's Report: Secretary Commerford stated that the minutes from the February 11, 2020 and March 10, 2020 were sent to the members via listserve email and asked for a motion to accept these minutes. Rick Brideau made a motion to approve the minutes as written, seconded by Marti Noel. President Rice called for a vote; 14-0-0 in favor.
- IV. Treasurer's Report: Treasurer Scott Bartlett sent out via listserve the Treasurer's Report and Income and Expense Statement dated April 14, 2020. There was a question of how course fee refunds were being handled. Verna stated that some individuals did not want a refund because they were concerned with their town budgets being frozen. Rick Brideau made a motion to approve the report as presented, seconded by Marti Noel. President Rice called for a vote, 14-0-0 in favor.

Also, Treasurer Scott Bartlett sent out via listserve the Treasurer's Report and Income and Expense Statement dated June 9, 2020. Scott asked if he should show the course refunds as negative income or as an expense. All were unsure but thought it did not matter either way. Rick Brideau made a motion to approve the report as presented, seconded by Marti Noel. President Rice called for a vote, 14-0-0 in favor.

- VI. Regional Directors/County Directors Reports: No Report
- **VII.** Committee Reports:

By Laws: Tim Ballantine & Robert Gagne — Tim presented a change to the procedural rules suggested by Ethics Committee Chairman Rick Vincent. He suggested a change to the language to Rule 2.8.6 J. The language currently states "The decision shall include notice that the complainant and the respondent have thirty (30) days from receipt of the decision to appeal to the Executive Board..." Rick's suggestion is to change it to "The decision shall include notice that the complainant and respondent have thirty (30) days from *the date of the letter (or notice of decision)* to appeal to the Executive Board..." The reason for this per Rick is that the committee has no way of knowing when the parties received the letter. Scott Bartlett said that at the DRA level the complainant does not have the right to appeal so why should we allow it. Kris McAllister suggested deferring all ethics cases to the DRA. Norm Bernaiche felt that since the DRA already handles ethics cases we are performing at redundant task and we have limited resources to deal with complaints. Norm feels that since we have not discussed disbanding the Ethics Committee we should really deal with that first before changing the language in our procedures. President Rice suggested that the By-laws discuss this and come back to our next meeting with a recommendation to be voted on.

Certification: Rosann Maurice-Lentz—Rosann started a discussion regarding accepting on-line courses for certification. Currently, certain on-line courses are allowed for re-certification but not for CNHA or DRA designation. Need to be on the same page as the DRA. Also, question of whether to allow those recertifying in 2020 to extend the deadline for a year. Rosann will consult with the committee and make a recommendation to the Board. Tom Hughes stated that he would like to take the CNHA exam. Rosann stated that the exam needs to be reviewed and updated for recent legislative changes to statutes.

Also, Rosann asked if the NHAAO should purchase a Zoom account and whether the association would qualify for any covid-19 relief monies. Scott Bartlett stated he wasn't sure if the NHAAO could collect any Covid federal money but he felt the DRA might for education, etc. Sam Greene stated that he did not think the DRA or any State agency was eligible but said he would check.

**Communications:** Dave McMullen – No Report

Conference: Kris McAllister – Kris stated that the banquet is up in the air due to the virus. President Rice stated that the NHMA will hold a "virtual" conference in November. There was a discussion of whether we should cancel the banquet for 2020. President Rice felt it was too soon to make that call. This prompted a discussion. In the end it was decided to cancel the banquet at the Puritan Restaurant. Rosann Maurice-Lentz made a motion to cancel the 2020 NHAAO banquet scheduled for the Puritan on November 18, 2020, seconded by Marti Noel. President Rice called for a vote, all in favor 14-0-0. Motion passes. Emily Goldstein suggested that we leave the option open for some kind of banquet and to not divert funds labeled for the original banquet at the Puritan.

**Education:** Verna Sharpe –Verna stated that the committee met this morning via Zoom and thanked Steve Hamilton for the use of his Zoom account. The committee discussed allowing on-line courses for qualifying education for CNHA and DRA designation (currently on-line courses are eligible for recertification only). To that end, the committee came up with 3 points and are asking for the Board's

support. They are: 1. Allow the State Statutes courses to be <u>live</u> on-line with a proctored exam. 2. Allow <u>live</u> on-line IAAO courses for qualifying education. 3. If the Board supports <u>live</u> on-line education then bringing these items to the ASB to see if they would follow suit either on a short term basis or permanently. There was a discussion of all three points most notably would a camera be required to attend the course. Rick Brideau motioned for the Board to support Point #1 and #2, seconded by Norm Bernaiche. President Rice called for a vote, all in favor 14-0-0. Rick Brideau motioned for the Board to support Point #3, seconded by Marti Noel. President Rice called for a vote, all in favor 14-0-0.

Also, Verna said the committee is working on speakers for the NHMA Virtual Conference in November but is not ready to announce who will speak and what topics.

**Elections:** Mark Stetson – No Report.

**Ethics:** Rick Vincent – Rick stated that in March the committee issued decisions on complaints from 2019 and both the respondent and complainant have been notified.

**Finance:** Marti Noel – No Report.

**Legislative:** Jim Michaud – Jim stated that the current legislation session is on hold. The House will be meeting on Thursday June 11<sup>th</sup> at the Whittemore Center on the campus of UNH. Jim said the Senate has been meeting remotely and will have a voting session next week. He said they have consolidated many bills into 1 or 2 bills for voting purposes. He said the SB was not part of the consolidation and has probably gone by the wayside for this session.

**Membership:** Emily Goldstein – No Report, however, Emily would like for the committee to meet prior to the next meeting.

**Nominating:** Dan Langille – No Report.

Publicity: Beth Charlebois – Bill Ingalls stated that due to the coronavirus the booklet has yet to be printed and was unsure when it would be. Scott Bartlett made a motion that instead of a printed version for 2020 a digital version be made available to all members. Seconded by Kris McAllister. President Rice called for a vote 14-0-0 in favor.

**Scholarship:** Lee Ann Provencher – Lee Ann stated that the committee extended the deadline for Steve Tellier Scholarship to June 15<sup>th</sup>. She said they currently have 2 applications for the scholarship. The committee supports postponing the Cornhole tournament scheduled for September. They will be holding a cash calendar fundraiser in October. Also, she reported that Norm Pelletier said the golf tournament is a "wait and see" at this point.

#### **VIII.** Other Reports from Boards and Departments:

**NRAAO:** NRAAO Representative Rick Brideau – Rick stated that the 2020 NRAAO conference was cancelled. He said the NRAAO Board met via Zoom recently and Norm Bernaiche was elected President and he was elected Vice President for 2021. Bill Ingalls stated that our conference in 2021 is in jeopardy but no decision has yet been made.

**IAAO:** IAAO Representative Kathy Temchack/Rick Brideau – Rick stated that IAAO conference that was to be held at the end of August in Denver has been cancelled.

President Rice asked Sam when the Mosaic meeting will be held. Sam said that they are trying to coordinate a date convenient for all.

**New Business:** Norm Bernaiche suggested that since most may not be taking a vacation this summer that we hold a NHAAO Board meeting in August. All agreed and it is officially scheduled for August 11 via Zoom. Because the NHAAO does not hold a Zoom account it was suggested that President Rice look into the cost and work with Treasurer Bartlett on obtaining a license. Norm Bernaiche suggested that Treasurer Scott Bartlett be the account holder and not the President since that seat changes each year. Scott agreed.

Adjournment: There being no further business before the Association Board of Directors, President Rice asked for a motion to adjourn the meeting; no objection, 14-0-0, unanimous in favor, the meeting adjourned at 12:02 pm.
